

Leslie finishes 10th at Merrittville Speedway and 14th at Humberstone Speedway

May 18th, 2010 - Port Colborne - Not being able to qualify on Saturday prompted for a bad start Saturday night at Merrittville Speedway. Finishing one spot out of a qualifying spot in his heat, seventh, Leslie had to start from deep in the field in the 25 Lap main event May 15th. Starting from the 20th place Leslie would work his way up to tenth place in a one caution race. "The car worked really good out there tonight." elated Leslie, "I've never been this comfortable in this car yet this season. The car just gets better and better!"

Earlier in the night Leslie debuted his 2010 Tribute to the Troops paint scheme in the front grandstands. "We really got a good reaction from the crowd, everyone seemed to like it." The car includes a huge mural of a battleship at sea along the side of the car and the NAVY 100th Anniversary logo on the rear quarters.

Sunday was a completely different story as Leslie started on the pole in his heat and stayed there, winning his first ever heat win. "It's not much to gloat about but it's a huge confidence boost." The young driver stated.

This time starting on the outside pole. Leslie never got to the lead but fell back to 14th place finishing there. "We could of really tightened the car up, or done something different, it just wasn't working for me out there." explained Leslie. "But we'll try it again next week, hopefully things go better and we can finally get a top ten finish there."
